


Year 4 – Information Newsletter

Tuesday - spellings and maths plus regular reading

This half term, we are going to be learning about the importance of water. We will be locating sources of water including seas, oceans and rivers as well as studying features of rivers. We will also looking at the importance of water in the world.

In English...

This half term, we will be working with visual and written literacy. We will be watching videos to help use our imaginations to write a range of texts. We will also be continuing to build our grammar skills including apostrophes for possession, fronted adverbials and prepositional phrases.

READING Please continue to send Reading **Books into school every day** and **PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE read at home with your child at least 4 times a week.**

In Maths...

Following the mastery maths curriculum, we will start adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers using the column method. This will include exchanging so please practise this at home with your children. We will also be studying the perimeter of different shapes and problem solving activities related to this.

Remember, Year 4 need to know their 12 x times tables by summer so please use TTRS at home with your child.

In other subjects and opportunities...

Our **Science** focus will be States of Matter, including exploration of solids, liquids and gases. We will look at moving between the three states of matter by heating and cooling materials and note the changes in their properties. In **Computing** we will be developing our keyboard skills as well as using Scratch to create our own images and animations with Mr Ryan. Our **art** lessons will include sketches of river scenes as well as studying the work of Monet. A variety of mediums will be used to create the piece.
