- Half termly tracking of pupil progress and comparing to non-Pupil Premium peers
- Reviewing individual pupil's personal and social development and well being
- Comparing the progress and attainment of Hollywood Pupil Premium Grant pupils with comparative schools
- Professional dialogue with outside agencies and stakeholders with regard to specific interventions and pupils who are supported by these
